Violinist Line Kruse is known for blurring the lines. A Dane in Paris, she has explored Latin traditions with her strong jazz and classical background. A master at juggling Afro-Peruvian odd meters, she was a featured soloist with the unique/electro tango group Gotan Project which enjoyed world wide recognition.

In 2020, her album Invitation recorded with the Harold Lopez Nussa trio, flute master Maraca Valle and singer Dayme Arocena won her a warm welcome into the Habana Jazz Festival.

Her new album **bånd** captures her new compositions with some long-time friends, and it looks like *the best of* the Danish Jazz scene: Peter Rosendal (best Jazz album 2020), sax new star Frederick Menzies, Jonas Johansen (NHØP long time drummer) and Kaspar Vadsholt, Steen Hansen and Jesper Riis from the Danish Radio Big Band.

"I have called the album **bånd** (bound, in english), because it makes so much sense right now - a tribute to everything that binds us together, to our countries of origin and adoption, to our cultures, which are mutually enriched by meetings and good fortunes," says Line Kruse.
